

Board of Supervisors Minutes
February 6, 2023

The Tama County Board of Supervisors met at 8:30 a.m. February 6, 2023. Present: 1st District Supervisor, Curt Hilmer; 2nd District Supervisor, Bill Faircloth and 3rd District Supervisor, Dan Anderson.

8:30 – 9:00 Employee/Department Head Time

9:00-9:30 Public Comment Time The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Present: Supervisors Hilmer, Faircloth, Anderson. Tama County Auditor Laura Kopsa, several members of the Tama County Against Wind Turbines Coalition. There was not a Deputy Sheriff present. Roger Wacha Jr. was present and asked how much COVID relief money is left? He had heard it can be used for roads. He would like to see that done. The gravel roads are getting pretty bad and need to be kept up. Jon Winkelpleck spoke about being approached by a group of people recently asking if they have to sign easements. He stated that some of the county constituents are losing faith in the Supervisors. The Supervisors would like those people to come talk to them or call them. The group would still like a moratorium on any new wind projects and would like to see an industrial solar ordinance put in place. There are many rules and regulations on land and home owners that control what we can and can't do that we all must abide by.
