Pre-registered voters are required to provide an approved form of identification at the polling place before receiving and casting a regular ballot. Voters who are not pre-registered-such, as voters registering to vote on Election Day-and voters changing precincts must also provide proof of residence. A voter who is unable to provide an approved form of identification (or prove residence if required. 1) may have voter's identity/residence attested to by another registered voter in the precinct, 2) prove identity and residence using Election Day Registration documents, or 3) cast a provisional ballot and provide proof of identity/residence at the County Auditor's office by Thursday, November 10th. Election Day Registrant attestors must provide an approved form of identification. Voter pre-registration deadline is 5:00 P.M. October 24th, 2022 at the Tama County Auditor's office. Absentee ballots are available in the County Auditor's office during regular business hours. The Auditor's Office will also be open from 9:00 am until 5:00 pm on Saturday, November 5th, 2022, for absentee voting in the General Election.
