

**Board of Supervisors Minutes**  
**January 29, 2024**

The Tama County Board of Supervisors met at 8:30 a.m. January 29, 2024. Present: 1st District Supervisor, Curt Hilmer; 2nd District Supervisor, Bill Faircloth and 3rd District Supervisor, Dan Anderson.

8:30 – 9:15 Employee/Department Head Time

9:15 – 9:30 Public Comment on Agenda Items The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Present: Supervisors Hilmer, Faircloth, Anderson. Assistant Auditor Karen Rohrs, members of the public. Deputy Sheriff Killian was also present.

9:30 Motion by Anderson, seconded by Faircloth to approve the minutes of the January 22nd regular meeting and January 23<sup>rd</sup> public hearing meeting. All voted aye. Motion carried

The Board met with Ben Daleske, Tama County Engineer, to get a road projects report. There was discussion about creating a contract to have local farmers snow blow roads open when there is a major snowstorm. The board asked Ben to contact other counties to research what a contract might look like.

Motion by Faircloth, seconded by Anderson to approve the following resolution establishing Tama County voting precincts:

**RESOLUTION 1-29-2024A**

**Ordinance #I.6 Ordinance Establishing Tama County Voting Precincts**

WHEREAS, the Board has held three public readings, one each on January 22nd, 23rd, and waived on January 24th, 2024, concerning the proposed Ordinance #I.6 Ordinance Establishing Tama County Voting Precincts,

WHEREAS, the proposed ordinance provides for the establishment of all election precincts in conjunction with the most recent federal decennial census of Tama County, IA and in accordance with the addition of two more supervisor districts as the result of the November 2022 General Election. This proposed ordinance completely replaces the present Tama County Ordinance #I.5 in the Tama County Code of Ordinances,

WHEREAS, there were no written or verbal objections to the proposed Ordinance I.6,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, upon final publication of this Ordinance it be enrolled in the County's book of ordinances and in effect on the date of publication.
