March 4, 2024

The Tama County Board of Supervisors met at 8:30 a.m. March 4, 2024. Present: 1st District Supervisor, Curt Hilmer; 2nd District Supervisor, Bill Faircloth and 3rd District Supervisor, Dan Anderson.

8:30 – 9:15 Employee/Department Head Time

9:15 – 9:30 Present: Supervisors Hilmer, Faircloth, Anderson. Tama County Auditor Laura Kopsa, Assistant Auditor Karen Rohrs, members of the public. Deputy Sheriff Killian was also present. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Public Comment on Agenda Items: None.

9:30 Meeting called to order. Motion by Anderson, seconded by Hilmer to approve the minutes of the February 26th regular meeting. All voted aye. Motion carried

The Board met with Ben Daleske, Tama County Engineer, to get a road projects report. Daleske asked the Supervisors to approve Bridge Construction Agreement for Bridge #11340 within the shared County/City limits. This has already been approved by the City of Toledo. Motion by Faircloth, seconded by Anderson to approve a Bridge Construction Agreement for Bridge #11340 shared with the City of Toledo. All voted aye. Motion carried.

Motion by Faircloth, seconded by Anderson to approve the claims for payment as presented. All voted aye. Motion carried.

Motion by Anderson, seconded by Faircloth to set the canvas for the special election held on March 5th for Tuesday March 12th at 9:00 am. All voted aye. Motion carried.

Motion by Faircloth, seconded by Anderson to authorize the following Tama County representatives as signers on the new Auditor Clearing Account with Lincoln State Bank, Tama: Laura Kopsa, Auditor, Karen Rohrs, Asst. Auditor, Amanda Kriegel, Treasurer, Sara Gilbert, Asst. Treasurer. All voted aye. Motion carried.

Motion by Anderson, seconded by Faircloth to set up meetings to authorize a resolution declaring EMS an essential service in Tama County. These meetings will be Monday April 29, Monday May 6th and Monday May 13th at 9:45 am in the Supervisors meeting room. All voted aye. Motion carried.
